Dear Parents.

I am writing to communicate some of the changes that will take place surrounding your child's reading and phonics lessons for the rest of the academic year. Learning to read is the most important thing your child will learn at our school. Everything else depends on it, so we put as much energy as we possibly can into making sure that every single child learns to read as quickly as possible.

Your child will continue to bring home the following:

- A library book this is a book to be shared with, and read by you.
- A RWI core story book they will have read this 3 times already in school, it is a book for them to read to you, demonstrating their fluency and provides another opportunity to practice their 'voice choice' as they read.
- A RWI book bag book this is linked to the core story book, this book is new to them and should be read to you, allowing them vital opportunities to practice the skills and sounds taught in school.

A timetable at the end of this letter will detail when we aim to change these books each week.

Home Learning Expectations

We thought it would be helpful to summarize the homework tasks that will be sent home in a timetable. The timetable below details the days the home learning is set and expected completion day. We have suggested how these tasks could be spread across the week, into manageable short chunks of learning, rather than extended periods of home learning at a weekend that can become overwhelming for all concerned. However, we appreciate that every family is different and spending time together at a weekend completing home learning may work best for your family.

Creative Homework

Each half term you will continue to receive a Curriculum Newsletter linked to our topic. These newsletters are emailed to you from the school office within the first few weeks of the new term and are also posted on our school website. Within the newsletter there is a 'Things to do at Home' section, you will find a range of creative homework ideas for your child to select from. We would like them to complete one of these tasks in addition to reading and Maths Whizz. If they are keen to complete more than one task, that is equally acceptable. Allow your child to complete the homework task themselves (as much as possible) encourage them to use the cursive style handwriting, draw their own illustrations, build their own models etc. There will be a completion date to these tasks.
