With reference to the Education Reform Act (1988) the school is obliged by law to point out that payment is made entirely on a voluntary basis and you are under no obligation to make a contribution.

It is, however, important to point out that the school has no alternative source of funding and this activity will only go ahead if parents see fit to make a voluntary contribution of £19.00. For parents receiving a Job Seekers Allowance, Income Support or Family Credit the school will offer financial assistance in the strictest confidence. Please contact the school office if you are unable to pay for this trip.

The children will be leaving school at approximately 9.15am and will arrive back approximately 1.00p.m. Children will wear their normal school uniform.

As the children do not return to school until after school lunches have finished, please provide a packed lunch which will be eaten at school upon our return.
